**Acceptable Attire for Females**

- ❖ Dress slacks, skirts, or dresses, and dress shoes must be worn.
- ❖ **No shorts, jeans**, cargo pants, pajamas/loungewear, workout wear, overalls, or casual shoes (i.e., “flip-flops,” Birkenstocks, boots, slippers, or athletic shoes) will be permitted.
- ❖ Mortarboards are to be worn straight; style hair accordingly.
- ❖ Only writing with the graduation year will be allowed on top the cap, but cannot be 3D.
- ❖ Purses, parcels, packages, electronic devices (such as, but not limited to ipods, mp3 players, cameras, **cell phones**), corsages, or extraneous items (such as, but not limited to Silly String, beach balls, golf balls, confetti, streamers, balloons, horns, or whistles) are **NOT ALLOWED**.
- ❖ **No** decorations, or attachments of any kind are permitted on the mortarboard or the graduation gown (except the tassel or school sanctioned collars). Kristy will cover what has been approved.
- ❖ Face painting (or writing/markings on any visible portion of the face or body) and sunglasses are prohibited.

**Acceptable Attire for Males**

- ❖ Dress slacks, black jeans, collared dress shirts (short or long sleeved), **tie**, dress socks, and dress shoes must be worn, dress boots, **NO ATHLETIC SHOES**.
- ❖ **No shorts**, cargo pants, pajamas/loungewear, workout wear, overalls, or casual shoes (i.e., “flip-flops,” Birkenstocks, slippers, or athletic shoes) will be permitted.
- ❖ Parcels, packages, electronic devices including (such as, but not limited to ipods or mp3 players, cameras, **cell phones**), or extraneous items (such as, but not limited to Silly String, beach balls, golf balls, confetti, streamers, balloons, horns, or whistles) are **NOT ALLOWED**.
- ❖ Mortarboards are to be worn straight; style hair accordingly.
- ❖ Only writing with the graduation year will be allowed on top the cap, but cannot be 3D.
- ❖ **No** decorations, or attachments of any kind are permitted on the mortarboard or the graduation gown (except the tassel or school sanctioned collars). Kristy will cover what has been approved.
- ❖ Face painting (or writing/markings on any visible portion of the face or body) and sunglasses are prohibited.

**It is the teacher’s responsibility to check “Appropriate Behavior” in classroom and on football field**

- ❖ Punctuality: Graduates who are *late* for lineup **WILL NOT MARCH**.
- ❖ Appropriate Conduct: If a BHS staff member at the check-in area determines that a graduate’s conduct, physical condition, and/or appearance are such that it could be disruptive to the ceremony, that student **WILL NOT MARCH**.
- ❖ Safety: Parents’ assistance in preventing **any** drinking at pre-graduation dinners or parties will be appreciated.
- ❖ Accountability: Graduates who disturb the ceremony **in any way** will be removed from the ceremony immediately and **WILL NOT** receive a diploma with the rest of the graduates. Diplomas may be obtained the following week from the front office after conferring with an administrator.

**AN IMPORTANT NOTE CONCERNING SENIOR BEHAVIOR:** Please be advised that any type of inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated at the graduation ceremony. Any senior who demeans or devalues any BHS student, faculty or staff, or disrupts the educational process in *any way whatsoever* will NOT be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony and will face appropriate disciplinary action. Our goal is to provide a graduation ceremony that is both dignified and memorable; your support in attaining that goal is greatly appreciated.
